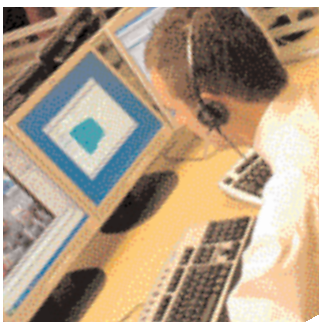


New regulations concerning intruder alarms came into effect from 1st October 2005. They affect all users and bring many benefits.

THE BENEFITS OF MONITORED INTRUDER ALARM SYSTEMS

The fundamental reasons why intruder detection systems are a 'must have' remain unaltered. They are, after all, very cost-effective, and so efficient too. Upon activation, they transmit the detail to our Monitoring Centre. Here, our analysts assess the detail and, if genuine, call the police and the nominated keyholders. But we live in an age of ever changing capability and our industry is no exception.

Recent times have seen the police insist upon the introduction of sequential signalling. Single sensor activations report as 'unconfirmed alarms' whilst multiple sensor activity reports as 'confirmed', so qualifying for their response.

Now, working standards and police regulation has moved the boundaries still further.

New system design criteria: PD6662

Positive news, addressing so many of the deficiencies of the past. Most commercial risks will be categorised Grade 3: Medium-High risk. Key improvements include:

- **Anti-masking of movement sensors**

To safeguard against this type of device being disabled or its effectiveness reduced whilst unset, they now must incorporate anti-mask diagnosis.

- **Activity monitoring**

Proactive self-checking that each detection device sees activity during unset periods. No activity within its determined period must auto report to the control equipment, forcing investigation.

- **Monitored dual-path signalling:**

A landline as the primary path with secondary GSM signalling should this fail. Should either or both fail, the Monitoring Centre is alerted within seconds to instigate response.

- **Standby power provision**

Battery power capacity & re-charging parameters have been substantially upgraded.

- **Components manufacture**

Equipment manufacturers forced to re-design virtually every system component to satisfy Grade 3 criteria, such were the deficiencies previously prevailing.
